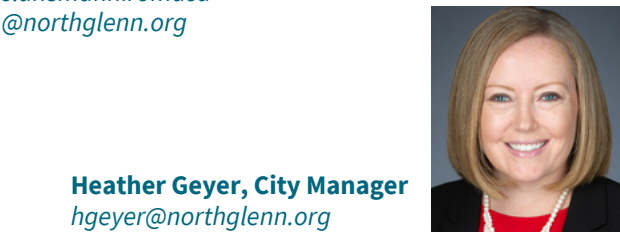

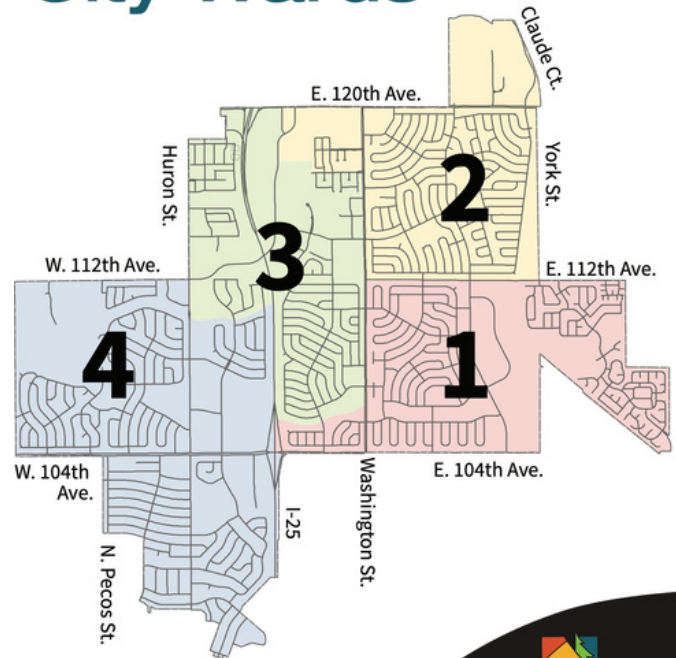

City Council consists of nine members, including the mayor. Two council members are elected from each of the city's four wards, while the mayor is elected at-large, by the registered voters. They are part-time and do not have an office at City Hall. Learn more about your council members at www.northglenn.org/citycouncil. The City Manager is appointed by the mayor and council and is the Chief Administrative Officer for Northglenn.

Council meetings are held on the second and fourth Monday of the month at 6 p.m. Study sessions are on the first and third Monday of each month at 6 p.m.
