Stay Local	Your local community	Help a neighbor or community member who is physically or cognitively unable to do yard work or shovel snow. And hiring someone to do this type of work presents a significant financial hardship for them. Acceptable work includes weeding, lawn mowing, spring/fall clean-up, shoveling snow, etc. The work <u>cannot</u> be done for a business or family member. You <u>cannot be paid</u> for this work.	Use the Court provided community service log. The person you do the work for must sign the form or provide a letter to the Court.
