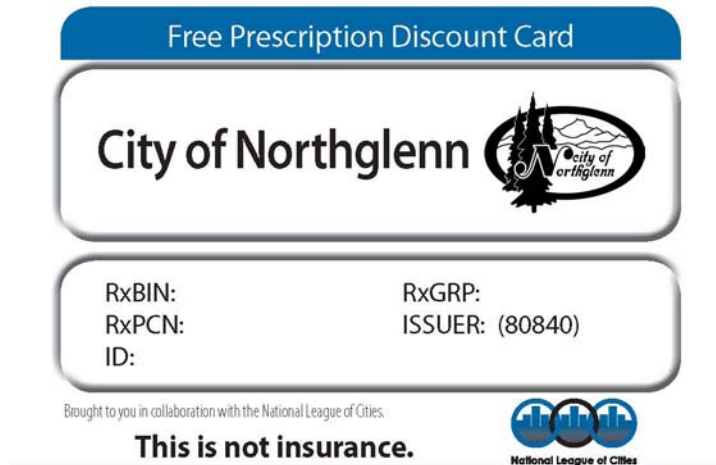


Save on Prescription Drugs...



With our new Prescription Discount Card!

The City of Northglenn has a new program to offer savings on prescription drugs to residents who are without health insurance, a traditional benefits plan, or have prescriptions that are not covered by insurance.

The **Prescription Discount Card** is made available to residents by the City of Northglenn in collaboration with the [National League of Cities](#) (NLC) and is made possible through Northglenn's membership in NLC.

The card is **FREE to all Northglenn residents**, regardless of age, income or existing health insurance. By using this card you **may save an average of 20%** off the regular retail price of prescription drugs at participating pharmacies.
