Polis Signs Tax Relief Bill at The Glenn Bar & Grill

Restaurants and food service industries who were hit hard by the pandemic, will see tax relief with the Qualified Retailer Retain Sales Tax for Assistance bill signed into law by Governor Polis on June 14 at The Glenn Bar and Grill in Northglenn.

The bill is a temporary deduction to retain the 2.9% **state** sales taxes collected in June, July, and August 2021 for qualifying bars, restaurants, mobile food and catering services, and hotel restaurants as a result of the economic disruptions that were negatively impacted by the pandemic.
